## Issue results of SNB Bills in US dollars of 4 January 2010

The Swiss National Bank (SNB) conducted an issue of its own debt certificates in US dollars (SNB USD Bills) today. The results for the terms offered are as follows:

The SNB USD Bills are offered with terms of 28,84 and 168 days; the denomination is USD 0.5 million. Participants may submit any number of bids; these may also contain different prices.
