SNB Research Conference – Exit Strategies

26 – 27 September 2014, Zurich, Switzerland

The Swiss National Bank is organizing a research conference on the theme *Exit Strategies*, to be held in Zurich on 26-27 September 2014. The conference will provide a forum for discussing a wide range of theoretical and empirical issues related to potential monetary policy challenges. Some of the topics that contributions to the conference might address include (but are not restricted to):

- strategy, communication and implementation of monetary policy during the exit
- instruments of unwinding unconventional policy (IOR, term deposits, reverse repos)
- central banks' balance sheets, the transmission mechanism and monetary policy with large excess reserves
- the timing of the exit and evaluation of the risks of being too late or too early
- exit to what? monetary policy after the exit
- lessons from the historical experience
- challenges for small open economies (exchange rate, capital flows)
- international dimensions of exit

Those interested in presenting their work at this conference should email a PDF file with a draft or detailed abstract of their paper to the organising committee at monetary.research@snb.ch by **4 April 2014**. Authors of accepted papers will be notified by 16 April 2014. A conference volume will not be published. Funding for transportation and accommodation expenses is available for presenters and discussants.
