Meeting of central bank governors of French-speaking countries in Berne

At the invitation of Jean-Pierre Roth, Chairman of the Governing Board of the Swiss National Bank, central bank governors of the French-speaking countries held their 14th meeting in Berne on 29–30 May 2007.

The central bank governors of the French-speaking countries come together once a year in one of the 50 or so member countries to examine matters of common interest and to exchange analyses and experiences. The first meeting took place in Paris in 1944.

The 2007 meeting was devoted to various aspects of the management of central banks. It was divided up into four sessions, covering central bank financial resources, the planning and budgeting process, the management of human resources, and the oversight of administrative and financial management.

Some thirty governors attended the meeting.
